






### Polio – The Disease

**Spinal** ~ 79%

**Bulbospinal** ~ 19%

Bulbar ~ 2%










#### **END POLIO NOW CAMPAIGN**



- > 1985 POLIO PLUS CAMPAIGN LAUNCHED
- > 2007 GATES FOUNDATION GAVE TRF A \$100 MILLION CHALLENGE GRANT FOR POLIO ERADICATION
- > 2009 GATES INCREASED INITIAL GRANT TO \$355 MILLION
- > 2013 GATES MATCH CHALLENGE: TWO-FOR ONE, UP TO \$35 (70) MILLION PER YEAR THROUGH June of 2017
- > \$50 (100) MILLION PER YEAR THROUGH June of 2020
- > ROTARY HAS RAISED <u>over 2 BILLION DOLLARS</u> FOR POLIO
- Over 2.5 Billion children Immunized against POLIO

**INDIA:** NO Wild Polio Virus - more than 7 years! **AFRICA:** NO Wild Polio Virus for 3 years!

World Wild Polio cases in 2018 = 22
















Our goal by 6/30/19 is \$40,000. The current amount raised is \$13,450.
