## Stock Slide

½-point drop falls short of Wall Street's hopes

The Federal Reserve lowered interest rates yesterday for the third time this year, but that didn't stop Wall Street from throwing a temper tantrum.

Stocks plunged after the central bank slashed its benchmark short-term rate 0.5 percentage-point, to

5 percent. Although the reduction was in line with market expectations, it fell short of the super-sized 0.75 percentage-point cut stock traders had hoped for.

The Dow Jones industrial average fell 238.35 to 9,720.76, more than 2 percent. The index is 17 percent below ts high, reached in January 2000.


